

## Poster Guidelines for the International Temperate Rice Conference

- Posters should be no larger than A0 format:
  - 117 cm (height) x 96 cm (width)
  - 46.5 in (height) x 37.8 in (width), in portrait format (no landscape).
- Figures should not be smaller than 12 cm x 18 cm and should have short, informative captions.
- 12 authors will be selected in advance to give a short thesis presentation on their poster topic. Presentations are limited to **three minutes maximum**. You will be allowed up to **two PowerPoint slides** to present with.
- Posters should be written in English and be a stand-alone visual representation of your submitted abstract.
- The title of your poster should be the same as the abstract and authors' names, organisation and a contact email address should be included.
- Important information should be readable from up to 2 metres. The committee recommends 48- to 60-point font size for headings and 24- to 32-point font size for the content.
- Text should be clear and to the point. Tables, graphs and pictures should be used to present results and concepts visually where possible.
- Introduction and conclusion are the two most important parts of a poster that invite further discussion. Make them simple, concise and visual.
